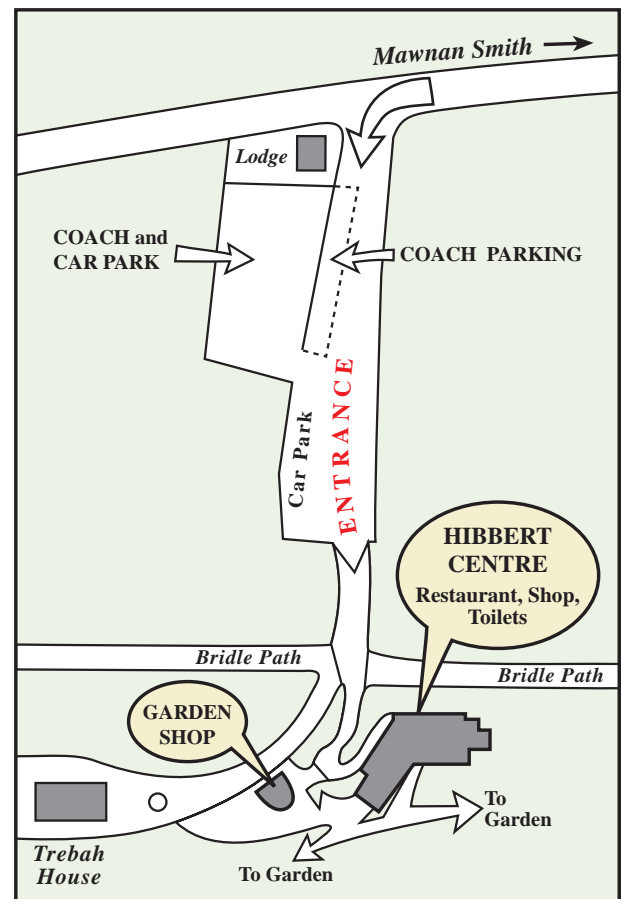
What else to enjoy

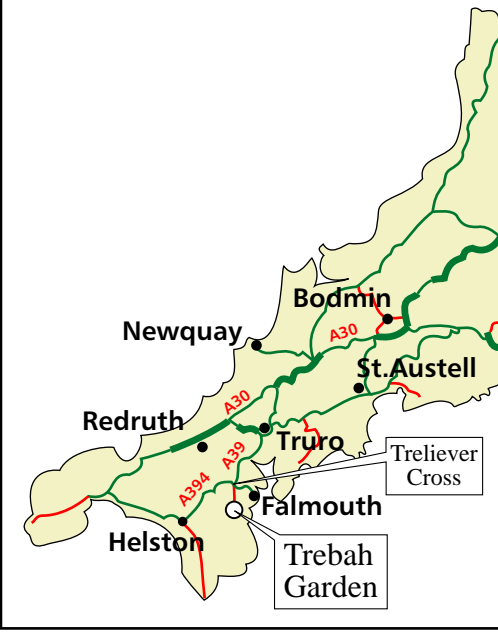
